DAYS 1 & 2

MONDAY & TUESDAY: FLIGHT & DUBLIN - SACRED TEXTS IN IRELAND

We depart the U.S. today for our flight to Dublin. Early arrival in Dublin and transfer to hotel. We will have a short rest then begin our tour. Today's sites include the Book of Kells at Trinity College, Dublin Castle and the Chester Beatty Library. We will have a special welcome dinner at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3

WEDNESDAY: MONASTIC CHRISTIANITY - ST. PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL

This morning, we visit the Glendalough Monastic Site. After lunch, we return to Dublin and stop at St. Patrick's Cathedral. We will have free time in Dublin city center to either take a walk down Grafton Street or walk around St. Stephen's Green Park. Dinner at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 4

THURSDAY: PRE-CHRISTIAN IRELAND & REFORMATION WAR IN IRELAND - C.S. LEWIS - ST. PATRICK

Today, we visit the Boyne River Valley and Newgrange & Knowth Megalithic sites: Pre-Christian Pagan Ireland. We will grab a quick lunch grab then visit the site of the Battle of the Boyne 1690, a decisive battle in the spiritual and national divide of the UK (Northern Ireland) and Ireland today. We travel to Northern Ireland toward Belfast enjoying beautiful views including the Mourne Mountains that inspired CS Lewis's Narnia. We will stop at St Patrick's Visitor Center. Nearby at Down Cathedral is St Patrick's official grave. Dinner and overnight in Belfast. (B, D)

DAY 5

FRIDAY: BELFAST CITY - ARMAGH (CHRISTIAN CAPITAL OF IRELAND)

This morning, the City of Armagh, where we visit both St. Patrick's Cathedrals. After lunch in Armagh town, we will visit the Titanic Museum. Dinner back at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 6

SATURDAY: DEVENISH ISLAND MONASTERY

Today, we travel to Enniskillen to visit Lough Erne. We board the MV Kestrel waterbus to visit the monastic site on Devenish Island. Afternoon: Free time in Belfast where you may visit the Titanic Distillers, walk through Belfast City Center, visit Belfast City Hall or enjoy some time to shop. Dinner back at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 7

SUNDAY: DEVENISH ISLAND MONASTERY

Today, we will worship and then have lunch with local believers in Belfast. Afternoon: Free time in Belfast where you may visit the Titanic Distillers, walk through Belfast City Center, visit Belfast City Hall or enjoy some time to shop. Dinner back at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 8

MONDAY: THE NORTH COAST

Today, This morning we check out of our hotel and drive to the Giants Causeway. We will visit Dunluce Castle then have a late lunch in Portstewart/Portrush and enjoy an afternoon walk. We will fly to Edinburgh from Belfast City Airport (BHD) and check in to our hotel in Edinburgh for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 9

TUESDAY: HADRIAN'S WALL - THE ROMANS & CHRISTIANITY

Today, we depart for Housesteads Roman Fort – Hadrian's Wall and explore past Roman presence and the eventual rise of Christianity through Constantine. We return to Edinburgh late afternoon for shopping on Princes Street. Dinner at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 10

WEDNESDAY: EDINBURGH CITY

This morning, we have a short drive to Edinburgh Castle. We walk down the Royal Mile visiting St. Giles and John Knox's House and the Holyrood Palace. After lunch, we are in St. Andrews, the ecclesiastical and educational capital of Scotland as well as the home of Golf! We will have a special farewell dinner in St. Andrews area to end this amazing trip. (B, D)

THURSDAY: RETURN FLIGHT TO THE U.S.A.

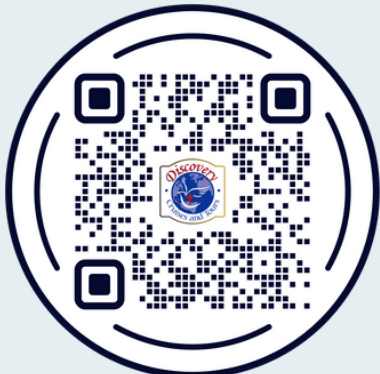
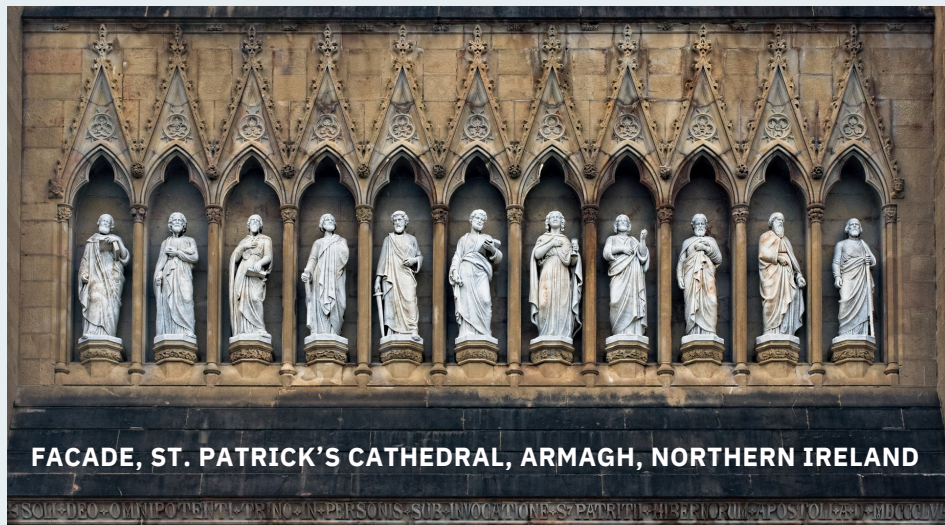

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PRICING: Our pricing is in U.S. dollars, and is based upon the current rate of international exchange between the U.S. dollar and foreign currencies at the time prices are posted. Whenever possible, **Discovery** obtains price guarantees from its suppliers, but in rare circumstances, a price increase may be unavoidable due to an increase in fees, including fuel surcharges, carrier surcharges, taxes, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination thereof. In that instance, the increase will be charged to the traveler up to the time of departure. Up-to-date pricing can be found at dcttravel.com.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICING: Passport costs, optional pre/post hotel nights due to traveler's arrival and departure preferences, hotel or other costs incurred to accommodate travel connections, items of a personal nature, including, but not limited to, laundry, non-included meals, room service at hotel(s), phone calls, Internet, etc.

TRAVEL PROTECTION INSURANCE: **Discovery** recommends purchasing a travel protection plan that helps offset costs and expenses should something unexpected occur. There are various plans available which cover Trip Cancellation, Trip Interruption, Emergency Medical and Emergency Evacuation, Emergency Repatriation, Trip Delay, Baggage Delay, and more. **Discovery** does not offer travel insurance, but many plans are available for purchase elsewhere, including, for example, at MissionSafe.

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS: Passports are required for all travelers, including children. **Passports must remain valid for 6 months beyond the completion of your travel dates; and are required for air travel outside the U.S.** For U.S. citizens and residents, more information is available online at www.travel.state.gov/passport, or by calling the National Passport Information Center at 877-487-2778. When necessary, a group visa for U.S. citizens will be obtained by **Discovery** for those confirmed by the final payment date. Non-U.S. citizens and U.S. citizens originating from outside the U.S. should consult their country's embassy regarding specific requirements for entry into each and every country of destination. **Your passport name must match the name on your registration, cruise boarding pass, and airline ticket, or you may be denied travel.** It is the personal responsibility of each passenger to fully comply with all immigration and documentation requirements.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Travel suppliers (cruise line, air carrier, shore excursion agents, etc.) may have restrictions regarding certain physical requirement accommodations. If you have a medical condition (mobility limitations, pregnancy, etc.), or use medical equipment which could affect your travel, consult your physician and notify **Discovery**, so we can provide you with information regarding possible restrictions. If you are unable to get on and off the bus and walk without the assistance of another individual, you must bring someone with you to provide assistance, or you may stay on the bus as needed.

PAYMENT INFORMATION: Final payments **MUST** be received ninety (90) days prior to departure. Payments received inside ninety (90) days will be assessed an \$80 late payment fee. **NOTE: All reservations not fully paid by the ninety-day deadline are subject to cancellation, and Discovery will not be held responsible.** Cancellation of airline seats or changes to passport registrations within one hundred (100) days of departure each carry a penalty of \$100 per person. Registration deposits must be made online by credit card, and subsequent payments may be made online by credit card or by mailed payment methods, including personal checks, cashier's checks, money orders, and credit card checks drawn against your card. Subsequent payments made online by credit card incur a 2.25% processing fee, but NO processing fee is charged for the deposit at time of registration.

REGISTRATION & DEPOSIT: **A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration.** The deposit may be charged to your **Visa, Mastercard, American Express,** or **Discover** card. Registrations received within ninety (90) days of departure must be paid in full. A late registration may result in an additional fee for airfare, depending on the airline and seating availability.
