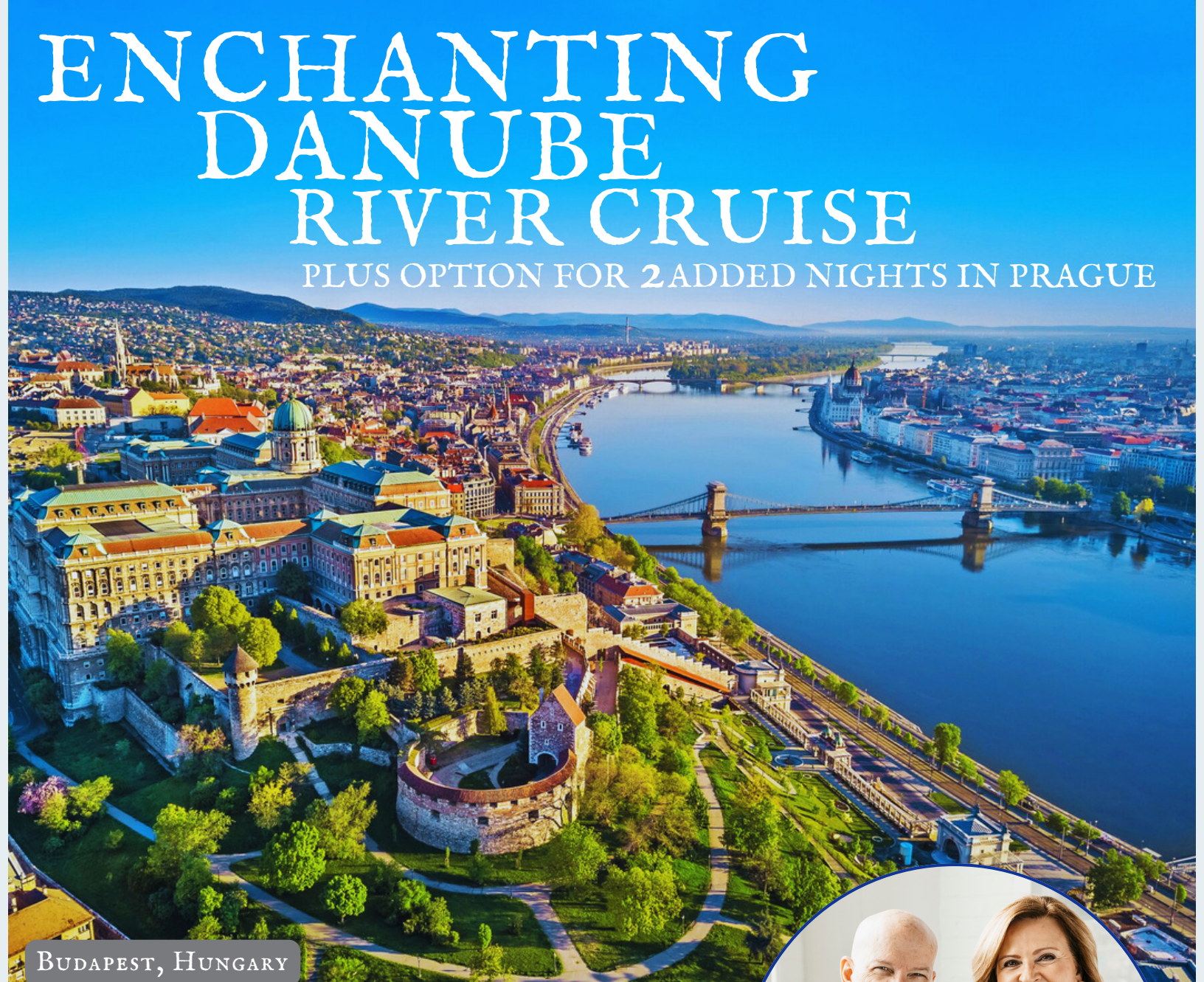

DAY 1 (June 6)

DEPART U.S.A. - EMBARK IN BUDAPEST

Depart the U.S.A. for a flight into Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport, Hungary. Arrive in Budapest, and board your luxurious river cruise ship, the S.S. Maria Theresa. Captain's Welcome Reception and Gala Dinner. (D)

DAY 2 (June 7)

BUDAPEST

Today, your guide will show you how to snack around Budapest like a local, starting with a tram ride to the House of Parliament. Hop off the tram and take a short walk to your first treat: a coffee break at the First Strudel House of Pest. Energized by your cup of coffee, you'll continue your walk down to St. Stephen's Basilica—a handsome Neo-Classical building that is one of Budapest's most significant cultural sites. From there, we'll head to the Great Market Hall to sample some traditional Hungarian fare, such as salami, sausages, and cheese, while your local expert explains the intricacies of Hungarian cuisine. DAY 3 (June 8)

BRATISLAVA, VIENNA

Your ship sets sail from Bratislava later this morning and heads for Vienna today. You may relax onboard all day, perhaps enjoying a drink on the Sun Deck and taking in the scenery as the ship winds its way along the Danube River. When you arrive in Vienna, you'll cap off your day with a concert at the House of Strauss. Host to the crowning ceremonies of 11 Hungarian kings and queens between 1536 and 1830, Bratislava certainly has earned the title "Coronation City of Kings," as you'll discover during your walking tour. Take some time to browse through the shops and sample local delicacies in Old Town. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 (June 9)

VIENNA

Vienna is a cultural treasure trove revered for its art and music (and sinfully rich pastries). Experience the "City of Waltzes" with a highlight tour of the city, as well as an expertly led tour of an extraordinary collection of art at the renowned Vienna Art History Museum. You have leisure time after your tour to explore Vienna on your own. You might wish to visit the Albertina Museum, which houses one million old-master prints and an impressive collection of works by 19th- and 20th-century painters, ranging from Renoir to Rothko. For a wonderful view of the region, ride the Ferris wheel in Prater Park. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 (June 10)

DÜRNSTEIN, MELK

Dürnstein is a favorite town along the Danube, a lovely place to wander cobblestone lanes, browse quaint shops, and maybe hike up to a ruined castle (with an intriguing tale all its own). You can also opt for a tasting or learn all about the world's costliest spice from the Wachau Valley's only saffron grower, or visit a winery for a tasting experience. Later, visit the 900-year-old Melk Abbey and its extraordinary baroque-style library and delightful gardens. You have two ports of call in the incredibly scenic valley, and an assortment of delightful ways to explore this lovely region. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 (June 11)

LINZ, SALZBURG

Mozart's birthplace of Salzburg is nestled in a glorious alpine setting that sparkles like a winter wonderland. Linz may be best known for its famous Linzer torte, but it's also a hotbed for the arts. See the sights with a local expert and visit a family at their farm in the countryside. Austria's third-largest city, Linz boasts a long history of trading and textile manufacturing, but these days it is perhaps best known for its electronic arts and annual festival. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 (June 12)

PASSAU

Discover the city of Passau, a crossroads in more ways than one, as three rivers meet here and three nations nearly do, making for a fascinating cultural mosaic. Get to know the town and its main claim to fame—Europe's largest pipe organ—or "Let's Go" with an invigorating riverside hike, or opt to participate in a scavenger hunt. In the evening, a special Captain's Farewell Reception and Gala Dinner. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 (June 13)

DISEMBARK PASSAU, PRAGUE

Disembark the ship. (B) **Travelers who did not select the Prague extension will disembark and catch their flights, at Munich Airport.** Visiting the "City of Spires" is the perfect way to end your enchanting cruise. Prague has been a center of arts, commerce, and politics for a thousand years, and it offers a stunning array of medieval, baroque, and art nouveau architecture. Once you disembark the ship, you will be transferred to Prague by motorcoach. This evening, you can choose to rest up at the hotel or go out and explore the city. Nové Město, established in 1348, is one of Prague's four primary historical districts and, as such, is a neighborhood filled with iconic sites and traditional bites. Explore the area and enjoy cocktails or a local Pilsner with some of Czech foods, including its famed sweet treats. (B,L,D)

DAY 9 (June 14)

PRAGUE

After breakfast, begin a magical tour of the city of Prague. Many of the buildings in the UNESCO-designated city core date to the 14th century; Prague Castle dates back even earlier, as construction on the oldest parts of the complex began in the 9th century. A drive across the Vltava River (aka the Moldau River), brings you to the sprawling complex of towers, halls, cathedrals, courtyards, and houses, where kings, emperors, and presidents have had their offices for almost a millennium. Step down from the motorcoach and walk inside the castle's protective walls, taking in the Gothic structure of St. Vitus Cathedral, which took 600 years to build, and Vladislav Hall, whose intricate stone-vaulting system was one of the most advanced engineering feats of the late Middle Ages. After visiting St. Vitus Cathedral and the Old Royal Palace, you can choose between re-boarding the motorcoach for a ride back to the hotel or continuing your guided walk through the picturesque Lesser Quarter to Charles Bridge, one of the city's most famous landmarks. The walking tour will end in Old Town Square, which is surrounded by majestic buildings, including the Church of Our Lady before Týn and Prague's City Hall, which boasts a famous medieval astronomical clock. (B,L,D)

DAY 10 (June 15)

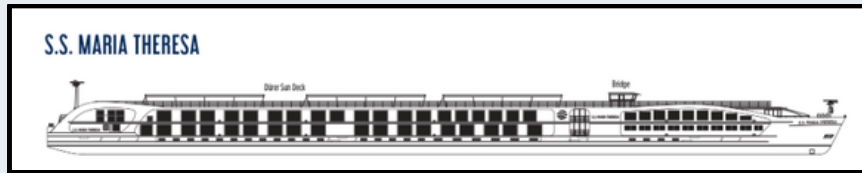
PRAGUE - DEPART FOR U.S.A.

DECK PLAN

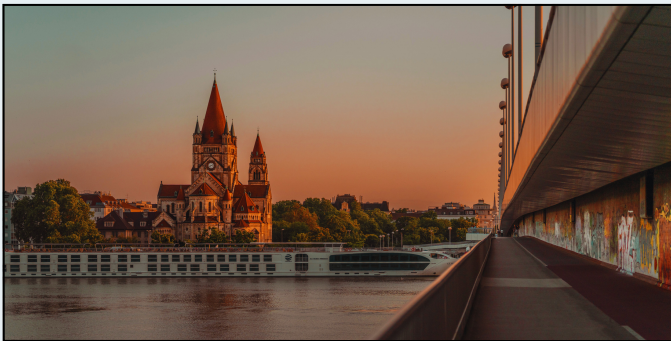

ENCHANTING DANUBE RIVER TOUR MAP



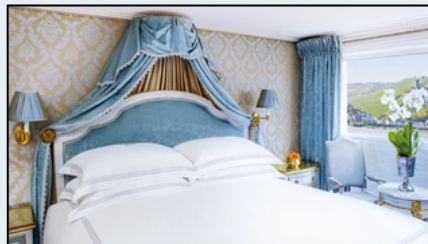

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PRICING: Our pricing is in U.S. dollars, includes a trip planning service fee and is based upon the current rate of international exchange between the U.S. dollar and foreign currencies at the time prices are posted. Whenever possible, **Discovery** obtains price guarantees from its suppliers, but in rare circumstances, a price increase may be unavoidable due to an increase in fees, including fuel surcharges, carrier surcharges, taxes, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination thereof. In that instance, the increase will be charged to the traveler up to the time of [departure](#). Up-to-date pricing can be found at [dcttravel.com](#).

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICING: Flights, passport costs, optional pre/post hotel nights due to traveler's arrival and departure preferences, hotel or other costs incurred to accommodate travel connections, items of a personal nature, including, but not limited to, laundry, non-included meals, room service at hotel(s), phone calls, Internet, ***tips for drivers and guides***, etc. *On excursions and post-cruise land tour, tips may be paid out at passenger discretion (in Euros).*

TRAVEL PROTECTION INSURANCE: **Discovery** recommends purchasing a travel protection plan that helps offset costs and expenses should something unexpected occur. There are various plans available which cover Trip Cancellation, Trip Interruption, Emergency Medical and Emergency Evacuation, Emergency Repatriation, Trip Delay, Baggage Delay, and more. **Discovery** does not offer travel insurance, but many plans are available for purchase elsewhere, for example, at [MissionSafe.com](#).

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS: Passports are required for all travelers, including children. **Passports must remain valid for 6 months beyond the completion of your travel dates; and are required for air travel outside the U.S.** For U.S. citizens and residents, more information is available online at [www.travel.state.gov/passport](#), or by calling the *National Passport Information Center* at 877-487- 2778. When necessary, a group visa for U.S. citizens will be obtained by **Discovery** for those confirmed by the final payment date. Non-U.S. citizens and U.S. citizens originating from outside the U.S. should consult their country's embassy regarding specific requirements for entry into each and every country of destination. **Your passport name must match the name on your registration, cruise boarding pass, and airline ticket, or you may be denied travel.** It is the personal responsibility of each passenger to fully comply with all immigration and documentation requirements.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Travel suppliers (cruise line, air carrier, shore excursion agents, etc.) may have restrictions regarding certain physical requirement accommodations. If you have a medical condition (mobility limitations, pregnancy, etc.), or use medical equipment which could affect your travel, consult your physician and notify **Discovery**, so we can provide you with information regarding possible restrictions. If you are unable to get on and off the bus and walk without the assistance of another individual, you must bring someone with you to provide assistance, or you may stay on the bus as needed.

PAYMENT INFORMATION: Final payments **MUST** be received (135) one-hundred-thirty-five days prior to departure. Payments received inside (135) days will be assessed an \$80 late payment fee. **NOTE:** All reservations not fully paid by the 135-day deadline are subject to cancellation, and **Discovery** will not be held responsible. Changes to passport registrations within one hundred (120) days of departure can carry a penalty of \$100 per person. Registration deposits must be made online by credit card, and subsequent payments may be made online by credit card or by mailed payment methods, including personal checks, cashier's checks, money orders, and credit card checks drawn against your card. Subsequent payments made online by credit card incur a 2.25% processing fee, but NO processing fee is charged for the deposit at time of registration.

REGISTRATION & DEPOSIT: **A deposit of \$600 per person is required at the time of registration.** The deposit may be charged to your **Visa, Mastercard, American Express, or Discover** card. Registrations received within (127) one-hundred-twenty-seven days of departure must be paid in full.
